WHAT IS THE ELECTRIC ENERGY SOCIETY OF AUSTRALIA (EESA)?

EESA is a national society established to advance interests in electric energy. It is a Technical Society of Engineers Australia. The key objective of EESA is to provide a continuous professional development program to members of the Society who have an interest in the field of electric energy. This field encompasses generation, transmission, distribution, retail and customer end-use of electric energy.

Total membership is approaching 700 and there are active chapters in NSW, Victoria / Tasmania, Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia.

WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY?

- Provide opportunities for continuous professional development and networking within the industry.
- Run effective and profitable conferences and seminars
- Influence government electric energy policy
- Stimulate university engineering undergraduates to take up careers in power engineering
- Represent community interest on electric energy matters and promote members to the community.

WHAT INFLUENCE DOES EESA HAVE?

EESA has influence at many levels with state regulators, industry associations and with the various arms of the electricity industry.

WHAT CAN EESA DO FOR ME?

Continuing Professional Development today is mandatory for professional people, as is ongoing training for everyone. Without this your future prospects will be limited. You need to keep abreast of technical innovations, both local and overseas, regulatory, standardisation and safety changes, as well as Government and organisational policies. You need to be informed on developments outside your local area and overseas.

HOW DOES EESA ENABLE THIS VITAL WORK?

Through an annual conference, regular seminars, technical visits, newsletters and availability of mentors. The opportunity to present papers and interact with other presenters provides personal contact with experts from all over the world. Living in a vacuum is not an option.

WHO HAS ALREADY JOINED EESA?

Most of our existing members are based in Australia. There are also representatives from New Zealand and regional countries. They work in areas which include:

Generation, Transmission and Distribution Authorities, Universities, Consultants, Manufacturers and Energy Retailers.

WHO CAN JOIN EESA?

Membership is open to any person with an interest in the fields of electric energy generation, transmission, distribution, retail or end use. However, being a member of both EESA and Engineers Australia allows members to benefit from a broader involvement with all areas of engineering.

Policies are a reflection of the needs and requirements of our members. A National Council, elected from the members and supported by State Committees, manages and directs the affairs of EESA to meet these needs.

HOW IS EESA FINANCED?

EESA activities are financed from the income received from sources such as: members subscriptions, conference registration fees and rental of exhibition floor space at our conference and other events.

HOW MUCH IS MEMBERSHIP?

For 2007 the annual subscription fee is \$77.00, due on 1 July of each year. Retired members pay a fee of \$27.50 per year including GST. If you join after 1 May the fee covers full payment for the next year.

As a member you are able to attend the EESA Annual Conference and seminars by paying a reduced registration fee only available to members.
